**ADT WINS CONTRACT TO IMPROVE SECURITY ON AUSTRALIAN ICONS
- HARBOUR BRIDGE AND ANZAC BRIDGE -**

X July 2006 – The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) has selected ADT, a leading global electronic security company, to carry out an upgrade to its security systems on the Sydney Harbour Bridge and ANZAC Bridge.

The security upgrade to two of Australia's most iconic attractions includes more than 90 new cameras, including: thermal imaging, intruder detections sensors, infrared illuminators and intelligent video solutions (video motion detection and advanced recording and playback facilities).

ADT's contract with the RTA covers the design and installation of the security systems for both bridges and is stage two of an ongoing security upgrade.

Mark Norton, General Manager, ADT Australia said, "As a Heritage listed structure, any upgrades made on the Harbour Bridge must have limited effect on the original appearance of the icon. Working within these rigorous boundaries required ADT to take a flexible approach in providing a security system to meet these needs and ensuring the bridge's many uses (including BridgeClimb, cyclists and New Year's Fireworks) were not hindered."

"With more than 160,000 cars crossing the Harbour Bridge and 130,000 cars on the ANZAC bridge each day, our partnership with the RTA demonstrates ADT's commitment to ensuring that Australians are protected by the highest quality security systems, in an age of profound uncertainty", said Norton.

This contract win is the latest in a string of new appointments for ADT in securing key government infrastructures. ADT won a similar contract with Railcorp last year and more recently with Sydney Ferries demonstrating ADT's expertise and leadership in providing world-class integrated security systems.
